We are currently working on renovating greenside bunkers on Holes #2 & #6.

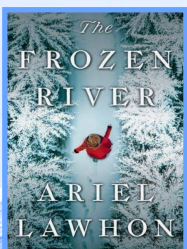

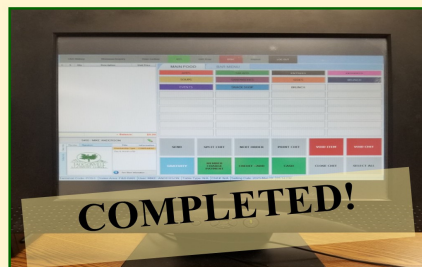
