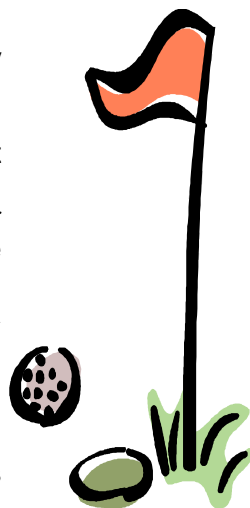
The C.D.G.A. has deemed our active season to post scores for handicap purposes to end on November 15th. We will then transition into the "inactive season."
