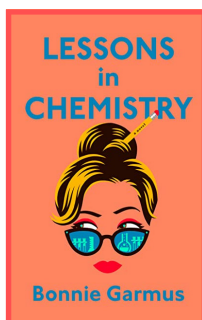

It is hard to believe October is already here. Soon, the leaves will be turning and sporting the colors of autumn. I believe September and October are often the best months to play.

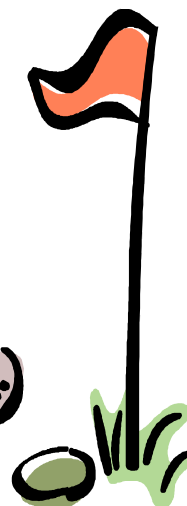
The C.D.G.A. has deemed October 31st as the last day to post scores for handicap purposes. We will then move into the "inactive season."
