One of the main goals for the fall is to maintain turf conditions for healthy turf the following year. We will be aerifying tees on September 11th to reduce the thatch. Greens aerification is scheduled for October 2nd and 3rd. We will be punching a deep hole and top-dressing after with sand. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

The pretty leaves bring a challenge during fall with the leaves constantly falling on the course. The maintenance staff will do its best to minimize disturbances while playing. We will blow, mulch, and vacuum up the leaves around the course to provide the best playing conditions possible. Some days may seem worse than others, but know that the maintenance staff is doing its best to keep up.

We hope that you all are enjoying the activities the club has to offer. We look forward to seeing you out this fall.

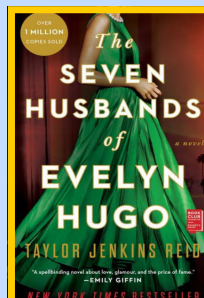

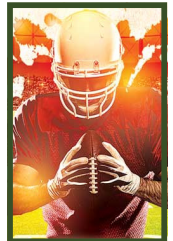

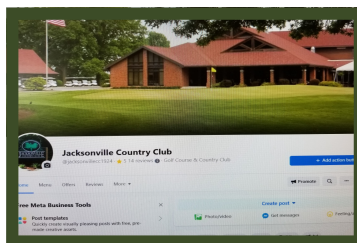
