## Casual Dining Room Project Update

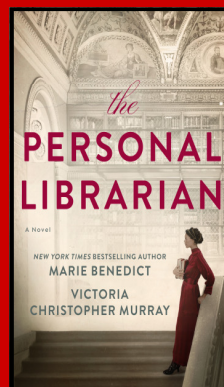


*The casual dining room project in honor of staff member Tracey Carlin is complete. We have new lighting, valances, pictures, and more.*
