It's starting to look like we are going to need a tropical storm to break out of this drought. On a positive note, the lower evening temperatures and lower humidity have allowed the poa annua to survive. We do our best to keep plant protectants applied but mother nature ultimately decides when we are able to do so. The irrigation system is doing its best to keep up with the warmer temperatures and the lack of rain.

During this time of summer, the turf is stressed to its limits. You can help by repairing ball marks, filling divots, and observing the



cart rules. Using the cart paths instead of the green surrounds is a big help.

We are looking forward to a successful summer. The maintenance staff is working hard to provide the best playing conditions for members and tournaments held here at the course.
