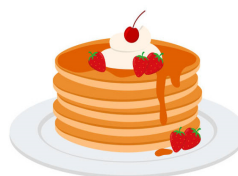

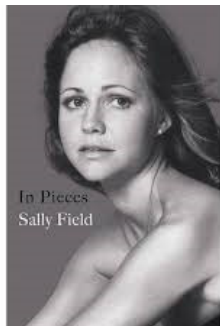

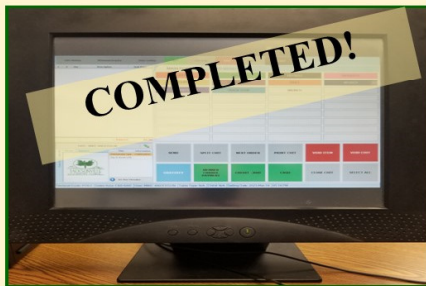

From the Golf Pro

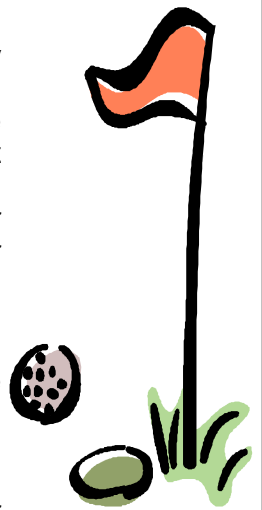
It is hard to believe October is already here. Soon, the leaves will be turning and sporting the colors of autumn. I believe September and October are often the best months to play.
